Planning points for roll preparation, identification, protective packing and shipment documents.

DOCUMENT PURPOSE

Confirm buyer and destination requirements before production. Fixed roll lengths, special labels, pallets and document formats may affect cost and lead time.

## Prepared for fabric sourcing and project discussion

This reference does not constitute a certificate, test report, product warranty or final order specification.

# Working Guide

## Roll Preparation

Define how the fabric should be presented and handled.

- Roll-length preference and acceptable range.
- Tube, folding or face direction where relevant.
- Lot or shade grouping and roll sequence.
- Special handling for delicate surfaces or coatings.

## Labels and Marks

Use project-specific data so rolls can be traced at receipt.

- Purchase order, item, color and roll number.
- Gross, net or measured quantity as agreed.
- Barcode format and buyer label template.
- Outer shipping marks and destination details.

## Shipment Documents

Align packing information with the commercial shipment plan.

- Packing list and roll-level quantity record.
- Commercial documents required by the agreed Incoterm.
- Material or test documents confirmed for the order.
- Booking, pallet and destination instructions.
