Printed Fabric Artwork Preparation Guide

File, repeat, scale and color information that helps reduce avoidable print-development revisions.

DOCUMENT PURPOSE

This guide supports artwork handover and strike-off review. The production method, printable width, color route and file suitability remain subject to project review.

Prepared for fabric sourcing and project discussion

This reference does not constitute a certificate, test report, product warranty or final order specification.

Working Guide

Artwork Package

Send one clearly identified master package and keep a matching copy.

- Editable or production-ready file in the agreed format.
- Full repeat dimensions and intended print scale.
- Separate color references or a physical standard.
- Placement, orientation and printable-width requirements.

Before Strike-Off

The base fabric can change color appearance and edge definition.

- Confirm the exact base construction and finish.
- Review repeat joins and directional elements.
- Identify critical colors and viewing conditions.
- State whether artwork scale can be adjusted.

Approval Feedback

Return one consolidated decision through the authorized project contact.

- Identify the submitted option being reviewed.
- Comment separately on color, scale, repeat and definition.
- Mark approved, approved with recorded comment, or revise.
- Retain the approved strike-off as the bulk reference.

Handover Checklist

Use this page as a discussion record. Add the applicable project values and obtain confirmation before sampling or bulk production.

Item	Required detail
File	Format, version and linked assets
Repeat	Width, height and direction
Color	Reference system or physical standard
Output	Base fabric, printable width and quantity
